THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1937.

REGULATION MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 5 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1937, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to make and hereby makes the following regulation:—

The regulations made by the High Commissioner under section 14 of the Elementary Education (other than Greek-Christian) Law, 1920, dated the 12th June, 1922, and published in the *Gazette* of the same date are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
