The Interpretation Law, 1935.

DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER SECTION 22.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 22 of the Interpretation Law, 1935, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to delegate and hereby delegates the powers mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto conferred upon him by the Laws mentioned in the second column to the officer mentioned in the third column.

2. The delegation of powers mentioned in item 1 in the first column of the Schedule to Notification No. 693 published in the *Gazette* of the 21st June, 1935, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

The Foreshore Protection Law, 1934.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Foreshore Protection Law, 1934, I, Robert Christopher Stafford Stanley, Commissioner of Larnaca, do hereby give notice :—

(1) that the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from any part of the foreshore lying within the Municipal limits of Larnaca is absolutely prohibited : Provided that small shingle up to $\frac{3}{8}$ inch in diameter to be used in the making of reinforced concrete may be removed from that part of the foreshore lying between the salt lake pier and the building used for disinfection of imported skins to the south of the Fort.

(2) that the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, nightsoil or other refuse on any part of the foreshore within the Municipal limits of Larnaca is absolutely prohibited.

2. The notice published in the *Gazette* of the 15th February, 1935, under Notification No. 173 is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done thereunder.
