No. 30. THE BURIALS LAW, 1896.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 1176, published in the *Gazette* of the 4th October, 1935, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a burial-ground for the burial of the dead by the Orthodox-Christian Community of the village of Kato Dheftera, in the District of Nicosia:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Burials Law, 1896, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that, from and after the 15th day of February, 1937, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burial-ground above referred to has been provided.

**No. 31. Notification under the Tree Planting Village Areas
Laws, 1930 to 1936.**

ARMOU (PAPHOS) FUND.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, I hereby establish a fund for the village of Armou, in the District of Paphos, (hereinafter called the "Fund") into which shall be paid all fines recovered under the said Laws for offences committed within the Tree Planting Area of the village of Armou, as described in the Order of the Governor made the 30th December, 1936, and published in the *Gazette* of the 31st December, 1936.

The Fund shall be under the management and control of the Commissioner of Paphos for the time being.

The money in the Fund shall be utilized for works of public utility in the village of Armou.
