No. 65.     §     THE BURIALS LAW, 1896.  
ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 1.

Whereas the burial-ground situated in the village of Lefka, District of Nicosia, now in use by the Orthodox-Christian Community for the burial of the dead, is dangerous to the health of the said village :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Burials Law, 1896, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that a new burial-ground, in substitution for the burial-ground now in use as aforesaid, shall be provided under the provisions of the said Law.

Made at Nicosia, this 18th day of March, 1937.

No. 66.     §     THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.  
ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Philousa, in the District of Paphos, on the 9th day of February, 1936, it was determined by the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Philousa :

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described :

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Philousa has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Paphos a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed :

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor :

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Philousa.
