**No. 10. The Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938.**

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF  
KARMI UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938, the Village Health Commission of Karmi hereby make the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Village Health (Karmi) Rules, 1938, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this Rule, the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, published in the *Gazette* of 4th March, 1938, shall :—

(a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Karmi and to be incorporated herein, and

(b) apply to the village of Karmi.

(2) The rules set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938.

(3) Those rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, mentioned in Part II of the Schedule hereto, shall not apply to the village of Karmi.

PART I.

(*Rule 2 (2).*)

RULES TO BE SUBSTITUTED.

*Rule 3.*—In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, the following terms have the meanings respectively assigned to them, that is to say :—

“Animal”, save when in any part or chapter of these Rules otherwise defined, means any ass, camel, cow, goat, horse, kid, lamb, mule, ox, sheep or swine.

Health Commission of buckets or receptacles containing household refuse or manure within the area of the village, that is to say :—

For every bucket or receptacle of household refuse or manure s. p.  
for a period of one year or part thereof .. .. . 7 0

*Rule 87.*—The Village Health Commission shall on or before the 1st day of April in each year prepare a list (hereinafter in this part of these rules referred to as “the Occupiers’ List”), showing the name, occupation and place of abode of every occupier in the village and the amount of the annual rate assessed on each such occupier. The Occupiers’ List shall be dated and signed by the Chairman of the Village Health Commission.

*Rule 91.*—Every occupier in the village whose name appears in the Occupiers’ List shall on or before the 30th day of September pay to the Chairman of the Village Health Commission or to such other person as may be appointed Treasurer by the Commissioner, the amount of the annual rate assessed on such occupier.

### No. 11. The Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF KAZAPHANI  
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938, the Village Health Commission of Kazaphani hereby make the following Rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Village Health (Kazaphani) Rules, 1938, and shall come into operation on their publication in the *Gazette*.

2.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this Rule, the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, published in the *Gazette* of 4th March, 1938, No. 2637, shall—

(a) be deemed to be rules made by the Village Health Commission of Kazaphani and to be incorporated herein, and

(b) apply to the village of Kazaphani.

(2) The rules set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938.

(3) Those rules of the Village Health (Karavostasi) Rules, 1938, mentioned in Part II of the Schedule hereto, shall not apply to the village of Kazaphani.
