THE IMMIGRATION LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 8 (3).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 8 (3) of the Immigration Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that British Consular visas may be dispensed with in the following cases, that is to say in the case of—

- (a) nationals of Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Egypt, France, Iceland, Iraq, the Principality of Liechtenstein, the Netherlands, Norway, Palestine, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland ;
- (b) Sudanese passports ;
- (c) Italian tourists travelling to Cyprus ;
- (d) any alien who permanently resides in the Colony and who has obtained from the Principal Immigration Officer an endorsement on his passport under Regulation 4 of the Immigration Regulations, 1936, verifying the fact of his permanent residence in the Colony.
