THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1790

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

H. R. PALMER, Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Amendment Order, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Gazette: Order, 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order") and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Orders, 1936 and 1938.

- 2. The First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the following item:-
 - "10. Skimmed milk or milk with a fat content of less than 7%."
- 3. The Third Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following item:-
 - "3. Skimmed milk and any kind of milk, skimmed or not, with a fat content of less than 7%."
