THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAW, 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1794

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 29 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938; His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and hereby orders that the Irrigation Division of Aredhiou be dissolved and that any moneys in the hands of the Committee of the said Irrigation Division and the Treasurer thereof, and any moneys received at any time thereafter by such Committee and Treasurer shall be paid to the Commissioner of Nicosia to be utilized by him for such purpose of public utility in the village of Aredhiou as to him may seem fit.

No. 130. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 1.

Whereas the burial-ground situated in the village of Ayios Iacovos, District of Famagusta, now in use by the Moslem Community for the burial of the dead, is dangerous to the health of the said village :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that a new burial-ground, in substitution for the burial-ground now in use as aforesaid, shall be provided under the provisions of the said Laws.
