In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 (a) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Port (Zyvi) Order, 1938.
2. The place set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto the limits whereof are fixed in the second column of the said Schedule shall be and is hereby appointed to be a port for all the purposes of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1938.
