Zyyi	All that portion of the coast of Cyprus of a total length of three and a half miles commencing at a point one mile east of Zyyi Jetty, thence westerly along the coast to a point one mile west of Vassiliko Jetty.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 65 (d) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wharfage Dues (Imposition of Olive Stones) Order, 1938.
2. Wharfage dues for imports at the special rate of eight piastres per ton shall be levied upon olive stones landed at any port in the Colony.
