5. I agree that the Comptroller shall be at liberty to post at the premises as in paragraph 4 hereof mentioned such person as he may seem fit for the purpose of supervising the making of the cases as aforesaid and I agree, accept and undertake to pay to the Comptroller the expenses of any such person and any cost or expenses connected with the supervision exercised by such person as aforesaid.
