

**No. 196.****THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.****ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 74 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 74 (1) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and hereby orders that the tax mentioned in section 65 of the said Laws payable by the Maronite tax-payers of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be increased by the rate per thousand mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule hereto to provide the amount for the payment of loans or annual maintenance of the Maronite Schools of the said villages respectively.

**No. 197.****THE DISEASES OF PLANTS PREVENTION LAW, 1893.****ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Diseases of Plants Prevention Law, 1893, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Plant Diseases (*Icerya purchasi*) Order, 1938.
2. Within any area declared to be infected with the plant disease known as *Icerya purchasi*, Mask. the following provisions shall have effect, that is to say :—
  - (a) All or any trees or plants whatsoever within any such area as the Director of Agriculture may require shall be fumigated, sprayed, destroyed or otherwise treated as the Director of Agriculture shall require.

- (b) No trees or plants or any part thereof shall be removed from any such area without the written permission of the Director of Agriculture previously obtained and such permission shall be subject to such conditions as he may require.
- (c) Any person instructed by the Director of Agriculture may enter any land, garden, yard or any other place within any such area and may carry out such inspection and examination of any trees, plants or any parts thereof and carry out such treatment of the same as may be required by the Director of Agriculture as in paragraph (a) hereof provided.

**THE DISEASES OF PLANTS PREVENTION LAW, 1893.**

**DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 2.**

H. R. PALMER,

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Diseases of Plants Prevention Law, 1893, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a place infected with the plant disease known as *Icerya purchasi*, Mask.

**SCHEDULE.**

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 424 of Block A, Ayii Omoloyitadhes village on the road from this village to Nicosia and goes south-eastwards across the said road to the south-western corner of plot No. 11 of Block 25, Nicosia town, (the garden of the Colonial Secretary's Lodge); thence south-eastwards along the southern boundary of this plot to the road from the Gymnasterion to Government House; thence southwards along this road as far as the north-western corner of plot No. 62/4 of the said block; thence eastwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 62/4, 62, 62/3/1 and 355 of the said block, plots Nos. 272, 3, 273, 4, 5, 274, 226, 258, 257 and 224 of Block B, Ayii Omoloyitadhes village to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 224 on the road from the Pantheon to the English Cemetery; thence south-westwards along the said road to the fork of roads at the most northern point to plot No. 266 of Block B of Ayii Omoloyitadhes village; thence westwards along the road to the village of Ayii Omoloyitadhes, and continuing beyond the public fountain to the river Pedieos; thence north-eastwards along the right bank of the said river to the point of commencement, all which said boundary is shown edged in red on the Government Survey plan serial No. 1163.
