In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 48 of the Co-operative Credit Societies Laws, 1914 to 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Co-operative Credit Societies (Amendment) Rules, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Co-operative Credit Societies Rules, 1933 and 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Rules"), and the Principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Co-operative Credit Societies Rules, 1933 to 1938.
