ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1827

MADE UNDER SECTION 6 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 (1) of the Antiquities Law, 1935, His Excellency the Governor, on the recommendation of the Director of Antiquities and with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to direct and it is hereby directed as follows :—

1. Such parts of the Ancient Monument specified as item 4 in the Famagusta District in the Second Schedule to the said Law as are set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto shall be transferred from the Second Schedule of the said Law to the First Schedule thereof as item No. 36 in the Famagusta District.

2. The Ancient Monument specified as item 13 in the Famagusta District in the Second Schedule to the said Law as set out in Part II of the Schedule hereto shall be transferred from the Second Schedule of the said Law to the First Schedule thereto as item No. 37 in the Famagusta District.
