No. 26. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 204, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th November, 1937, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a burial-ground for the burial of the dead by the Moslem Community of the village of Phasli, in the District of Paphos :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that, from and after the 1st day of March, 1938, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burial-ground above referred to has been provided.

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.

Whereas His Excellency the Governor has under section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, by an order published under Notification No. 20 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* dated the 11th day of February, 1938, ordered the Town Committees and Village Commissions for Moslem Schools mentioned in the second column of the Schedule hereto to provide school buildings, premises, playgrounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings :
