SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

A PROCLAMATION.

H. R. PALMER, Governor.

Whereas by a Proclamation made the 22nd day of September, 1938, and published in the Gazette of the 23rd day of September, 1938, I, Herbert Richmond Palmer, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, did order and proclaim that on and after the 1st day of January, 1939, the boundary of the Town of Nicosia should be as set forth in Schedule A to the said Proclamation and that the Town of Nicosia comprised within the said boundary should be divided into quarters as set forth in Schedule B to the said Proclamation:

And whereas it has been made to appear to me desirable that the said Proclamation should be amended in order to postpone its coming into operation for a period of one year:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the said powers vested in me as aforesaid, I do hereby order and proclaim that the said Proclamation shall be amended by the deletion of the words "1st day of January, 1939," appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the words "1st day of January, 1940,".

Given at Nicosia, this 30th day of December, 1938.
