In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 (1) of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, and otherwise, and with the advice of the Executive Council, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Order, 1939.
- 2. The respective rates of postage set forth in the Schedule hereto shall be charged by the Postmaster-General in respect of parcels posted in the Colony of Cyprus for conveyance to the places therein mentioned.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation from and after the 1st day of January, 1939, and thereupon the Order in Council No. 1651, dated the 29th day of August, 1935, and published under Notification No. 997 in the *Gazette* of the 30th day of August, 1935, shall be revoked,
