In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 34 of the Newspaper, Books and Printing Presses Laws, 1934 to 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Newspaper ("Klio") Prohibition Order, 1938.

2. From and after the date hereof the introduction or circulation in the Colony of the Newspaper set out in the Schedule hereto is prohibited.

**No. 3.****THE CO-OPERATIVE CREDIT SOCIETIES LAWS, 1914 TO 1937.****RULES MADE UNDER SECTION 48.**H. R. PALMER,  
*Governor.*

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 48 of the Co-operative Credit Societies Laws, 1914 to 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following rules :—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Co-operative Credit Societies (Amendment) Rules, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Co-operative Credit Societies Rules, 1933 and 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Rules"), and the Principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Co-operative Credit Societies Rules, 1933 to 1938.

2. Rule 44 (2) of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "Governor" (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the word "Registrar".

3. Rule 44 (3) of the Principal Rules is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By the deletion therefrom of the word "Governor" (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the word "Registrar".

(b) By the deletion therefrom of the words "the Secretary" (line 5) and the substitution therefor of the words "a Secretary".

4. The Principal Rules are hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after Rule 59, of the following sub-heading and Rule :—

*"Removal of Members of Committees and of other Officers by the Registrar.*

59A.—(1) Notwithstanding anything in these Rules contained the Registrar may by an order under his hand remove any member of the Committee or any other officer of the Society, who in his opinion is unfit to discharge the duties of his office.

(2) Upon an order by the Registrar under paragraph (1) hereof—

(a) if the order relates to a member of the Committee such member shall forthwith cease to be a member of such Committee ;

(b) if the order relates to any other officer of the Society such officer shall forthwith vacate his office."
