In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 (1) of the Antiquities Law, 1935, His Excellency the Governor, on the recommendation of the Director of Antiquities and with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to direct that such parts of the Ancient Monument specified as item 4 in the Famagusta District in the Second Schedule to the said Law as are set out in the Schedule hereto shall be transferred from the Second Schedule of the said Law to the First Schedule thereof as item 34 in the Famagusta District.
