**No. 36. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1778

MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Potatoes) Order, 1938.

2. The exportation of potatoes to the United Kingdom between the 30th April, 1938, and the 30th October, 1938, both days inclusive, is prohibited save under the authority of a licence granted by the Director of Agriculture and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence.

**THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.**

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Mazotos, in the District of Larnaca, on the 19th September, 1937, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area (hereinafter called "the additional area") should be reserved as a Tree Planting Area of the village of Mazotos in addition to the Tree Planting Area of the village of Mazotos reserved by an Order of His Excellency the Governor and published in the *Gazette* of the 5th June, 1936, under Notification No. 531, (hereinafter called "the original area"):
