No. 43. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

H. R. PALMER, Governor.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 616, published in the Gazette of the 31st May, 1935, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a burial-ground for the burial of the dead by the Orthodox-Christian Community of the village of Kritou Marottou, in the District of Paphos:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that, from and after the 1st day of April, 1938, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burial-ground above referred to has been provided.
