

**No. 45. The Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937.**

## NOTIFICATION.

It is hereby notified that in exercise of the powers vested in him by the Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to approve the premises described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the person whose name is set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the person whose name is set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be a private warehouse for the warehousing of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule.

**No. 46. The Quarantine Law, 1932.**

## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and it is hereby declared that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 469, published in the *Gazette* of the 2nd July, 1937, is hereby cancelled.
