THE PUBLIC HEALTH (SUMMER RESORTS) LAWS,
1928 AND 1934.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 23.

Authority to the Public Health Board of Pedhoulas to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 23 of the Public Health (Summer Resorts) Laws, 1928 and 1934, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that the Public Health Board of Pedhoulas (hereinafter called "the Board") shall be at liberty to borrow the sum of two thousand and five hundred pounds (£2,500) subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say—

- (a) That the rate of interest on the sum borrowed shall not exceed six per centum (6%) per annum;
- (b) That the sum borrowed shall be repayable in ten equal annual instalments comprising sinking fund and interest;
- (c) That the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Board for the purpose of providing for the establishment of a municipal market and a slaughter-house within the Pedhoulas Summer Resort.

2. The Order of His Excellency the Governor dated the 17th November, 1937, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th November, 1937, under No. 206, is hereby cancelled.
