A PROCLAMATION.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Kakopetria and of Pano Platres;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Herbert Richmond Palmer, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 15th day of April, 1938, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Kakopetria in the District of Nicosia shall form part of the lands of the village of Pano Platres in the District of Limassol and that the boundaries of the said villages of Kakopetria and Pano Platres shall be altered accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

The boundary commences at the boundary stone marked S.A. 7 (situated at the junction of two streams at locality "Kannoures"), and proceeds eastwards in a straight line in the direction of the boundary stone S.A. 8 (situated about 13 yards north-west of the Government triangulation point No. 939/4) to the track from the locality "Kambos tou Livadhiou" to the main road from Nicosia to Troödos; thence south-westwards along the western side of the said track to the said main road; thence south-westwards and north-westwards along the northern side of the said main road to the point at which it is joined by a road from the Chrome Mine; thence westwards along the south side of the latter road to the point at which it is crossed by the stream from the locality "Muti tou Nekrotaphiou"; thence westwards in a straight line in the direction of the boundary stone marked S.A. 6 (situated on a footpath from Troödos to Mount Olympus about 50 yards south-east of the Government triangulation point No. 936/4) to the tributary of the stream "Koutsoulos"; thence north-eastwards down this stream to the point of commencement.
