**No. 82.** THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1788

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Anti-malarial Drugs (Restriction) Order, 1938.

2. The importation into the Colony of blue coloured quinine tablets and of any other drugs used in the treatment or prophylaxis of malaria if in the form of blue coloured tablets is hereby prohibited save under licence under the hand of the Director of Medical Services and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence.
