SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 82, THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 AND 1937.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1788

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Anti-malarial Drugs (Restriction) Order, 1938.

2. The importation into the Colony of blue coloured quinine tablets and of any other drugs used in the treatment or prophylaxis of malaria if in the form of blue coloured tablets is hereby prohibited save under licence under the hand of the Director of Medical Services and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence.

THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

H. R. PALMER,

, Governor.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Ayia Kebir, in the District of Nicosia, on the 13th day of January, 1938, it was determined by the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayia Kebir.

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described :

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Ayia Kebir has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed :

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor:

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the Village of Ayia Kebir.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :---

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayia Kebir in the District of Nicosia.

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :---

The boundary begins at the north-western corner of plot No. 175 of the Government Survey plan No. XXXI/14, locality "Keur Dere," on the road from the village of Tymbou to the village of Ayia Kebir, and goes north-eastwards along the boundaries of, and including in the reserved area, plots Nos. 175, 176, 169, 164, 140, 141 and 148 of the said plan to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 148, on the road from the village of Ornithi to the village of Ayia Kebir ; thence south-westwards along this road to the junction of roads at the most southern point of plot No. 248 of the said plan ; thence north-westwards along the road to the village of Tymbou to the starting point.

The area reserved comprises 148 donums approximately, as shown edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. 631/37.
