made under the said Law (which said Direction, Orders and Regulations are hereinafter referred to together as "the Principal Direction, Orders and Regulations") and the Principal Direction, Orders and Regulations and these Direction, Orders and Regulations may together be cited as the Boats Direction, Orders and Regulations, 1928 to 1938.

2. The following proviso shall be substituted for the proviso to paragraph 16 of the Principal Direction, Orders and Regulations:—

"Provided that during rough or foul weather or when passengers or any luggage are being landed or embarked at a place outside the limits of a port the owner or any boatman in charge of a licensed boat may charge such rates in excess of the rates set forth in the said Schedule as may be approved by the Superintendent of the Port."
