Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that an additional burial-ground shall be provided under the provisions of the said Laws.

The Quarantine Law, 1932.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and it is hereby declared that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 46, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th March, 1938, is hereby cancelled.
