

**No. 105. Notification under the Tree Planting Village Areas
Laws, 1930 to 1936.**

KITI (LARNACA) FUND.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, I hereby establish a fund for the village of Kiti, in the District of Larnaca (hereinafter called "the Fund"), into which shall be paid all fines recovered under the said Laws for offences committed within the Tree Planting Area of the village of Kiti, as described in the Order of the Governor made the 5th day of April, 1939, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 2717 of the 14th April, 1939.

The Fund shall be under the management and control of the Commissioner of Larnaca for the time being.

The money in the Fund shall be utilized for works of public utility within the village of Kiti.

No. 106. The Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938, the following Rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Neokhorio, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the *Gazette*. (M.P. 1373/38.)

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF NEOKHORIO.

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Neokhorio Rules, 1939.

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires:—

"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia;

"Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;

"Irrigation Division" means the Irrigation Division of Neokhorio;

"Law" means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938;

"List" means the list of the names and residence of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law;

"Works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.

3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 11th December, 1938. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall take place every third year in the last week of the month of November and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the 11th December, next following its election.

4.—(1) The Committee shall appoint a treasurer who shall collect the rates and charges assessed upon the proprietors mentioned in the list.

(2) The treasurer shall, on the 1st December in every year, prepare a statement of all rates or charges still due and unpaid on that date and shall forward such statement to the Commissioner.
