No. 129. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, His Excellency the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Special Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1939.

2. There shall be paid a special air mail fee on letters, printed papers, commercial papers, samples and postcards intended for transmission by air mail from the Colony to Palestine, Egypt, Syria or Iraq, at the rates set out in the Schedule hereto, in addition to the combined postage and air fee payable under the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1938, or the ordinary postage, late or registration fees.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 5th day of June, 1939, and thereupon the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1936, shall be revoked.

SCHEDULE.

Country of Destination.	Special Air Mail Fee per half ounce or fraction thereof.
<i>Palestine:</i> By air to Lydda	$\frac{1}{2}$ piastre.
<i>Egypt:</i> By air to Port Said, Cairo or Alexandria	$\frac{3}{4}$ piastre.
<i>Syria:</i> By air to Beyrouth	$\frac{3}{4}$ piastre.
<i>Iraq:</i> By air to Baghdad	$1\frac{1}{2}$ piastres.
