THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1865 MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, His Excellency the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Amendment)
Regulations, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Quarantine
Regulations, 1932 to 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Gazettes:
Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may

2. The Third Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby repealed 17.1.1936and the following substituted therefor:—

"THIRD SCHEDULE.

OVERTIME CHARGES.

Charg

Officer

1. Port Health Officer . . For inspecting at any time on any day before or after the hours of business and at any time on any Sunday or public holiday a vessel visiting the Colony, 8s. in respect of each such vessel.

Inspector,..(a) For work at any time on any day other 2. Health 1st and 2nd Grade. than a Sunday or public holiday before or after the hours of business, 1s. 6p. per hour.

(b) For work on any Sunday or public holiday 8s. per day:

Provided that if the officer works for less than four hours on any such day the charge shall be 4s.

3. Health 3rd Grade.

Paspector,..(a) For work at any time on any day other than a Sunday or public holiday before or after the hours of business, 1s. per hour.

(b) For work on any Sunday or public holiday,

5s. per day:

Provided that if the officer works for less than four hours on any such day the charge shall be 3s.

4. Quarantine Temporary Guards.

For 'work at any time on any day other than a Sunday or public holiday before or After the hours of business, $7\frac{1}{2}p$. per hour.

(b) For work on any Sunday or public holiday,

4s. per day:

Provided that if the officer works for less than four hours on any such day the charge shall be 2s.

for the purposes of this Schedule the hours of business shall be 8 to 12 in the forenoon and I to 5 in the afternoon."
