THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1936.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to widen a street in the village of Dherinia, in the District of Famagusta, which forms the chief means of communication between the said village and the village of Paralimni in the same District:

Now, therefore, I, Andrew Barkworth Wright, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, on whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Acting Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1936, do hereby declare the widening of the street, as aforesaid, to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Commissioner of Famagusta the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.
