No. 197. THE BANK HOLIDAYS LAW, 1928.

PROCLAMATION MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL
UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Bank Holidays Law, 1928, and with the advice of the Executive Council, I, William Denis Battershill, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that Wednesday the sixth day of September, 1939, is hereby appointed to be and shall be observed as a bank holiday for the purposes of the said Law.

Given at Nicosia, this 5th day of September, 1939.

No. 198. The Importation of Textiles (Quotas) Law, 1934.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 5 (3).

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 (3) of the Importation of Textiles (Quotas) Law, 1934, His Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified for general information that the imports of textile goods manufactured in Italy during the quota period as defined in the Proclamation dated the 24th September, 1938, and published under Notification No. 182 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 2677 of the 30th September, 1938, have attained the quota prescribed in the said Proclamation in respect of Italy.
