THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Conservation of Olive Stones) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
- 2. No person shall use as fuel in any bakery or public bath, or in any other way, any olive stones which have not previously been subjected to a crushing process in a factory.
- 3. Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
