THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make and hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Arrival and Departure) Regulations, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.
Citation and date of coming into operation.
2. The Governor may by order make provision for securing that, subject to any exemptions for which provision may be made by the order,—
 - (a) no person shall, on coming by sea or by air from a place outside the Colony, disembark in the Colony from any vessel or aircraft elsewhere than at a place specified in the order;
 - (b) no person shall, for the purpose of proceeding by sea or by air to a destination outside the Colony, embark in the Colony on any vessel or aircraft elsewhere than at a place so specified;
 - (c) no person shall proceed from the Colony to a destination outside the Colony, except under the authority of a written permit granted by such authority or person as may be specified in the order.
Restrictions upon entering and leaving the Colony.
3. The provisions of Part X of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, shall apply for the purpose of the enforcement of these regulations, and otherwise in relation thereto, as if any reference in the said Part X to those regulations included a reference to these regulations.
