THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) (ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by regulation 2 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Arrival and Departure) Regulations, 1939, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Restrictions on Departures from the Colony) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the 1st day of October, 1939.

2. Subject to the exemptions for which provision is made in clause 3 of this Order, no person shall depart from the Colony except under the authority of a written permit in the form set out in the Schedule hereto granted to him by the Commissioner of Police or by such police officer as may be authorized in writing by him in that behalf.

3. The provisions of clause 2 of this Order shall not apply to—

- (a) persons in the service of the Crown (including persons in the service of a Dominion Government);
 - (b) foreign Consuls de Carrière duly accredited to the Government;
 - (c) duly accredited officials of Allied Governments;
 - (d) police officers on duty;
 - (e) aliens holding transit visas.
