THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1880

MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Amendment Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Order, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Orders, 1939.

*Gazette :  
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2. The First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following goods:—

" Sheep.	Vetches.
Pigs.	Cotton seed.
Goats.	Sesame seed.
Camels.	Poultry (fowls, ducks, geese and turkeys)."

3. The Second Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the following words:—

" Poultry (fowls, ducks, geese and turkeys)."
