THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 55 (1).

In exercise of the powers in me vested by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 55 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Sound Signals Prohibition) (Larnaca) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. The sounding of sirens, hooters or any form of sound signal within the municipal limits of Larnaca is hereby prohibited :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to sound signals used by motor vehicles.

3. Any person acting in contravention of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
