THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

Order made by the Competent Authority under Regulation 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Essential Engineering and Building Construction Materials) Order, 1939.

2. Within seven days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is an importer, merchant, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any of the articles described in Schedule A hereto shall complete and deliver to the Director of Public Works at Nicosia in duplicate a return in the form set forth in Schedule B hereto in respect of all stocks of such articles in his possession or under his control.

3. Every person selling, whether by wholesale or retail, any of the articles described in Schedule A hereto shall keep on his premises such records as may be necessary to enable him to submit within two days after the last day of each month to the Director of Public Works at Nicosia a monthly return in the form set forth in Schedule C hereto, and shall submit such return monthly.

4. Every person selling, whether by wholesale or retail, any of the articles described in Schedule A hereto shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District in which his premises are situated, may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon his premises and make—

(a) such enquiries or inspection therein ; and

(b) such inspection of his books and papers,

as may be necessary for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with or of ascertaining the quantities of such articles in his possession or of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under this Order.

- 5. Any person who—
- (a) acts in contravention of the provisions of clause 2 or 3 or 4 of this Order, or
- (b) makes a false return under clause 2 or 3 of this Order,

shall be liable to penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

Order made by the Competent Authority under Regulation 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 9 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Places of Public Resort and Entertainments) (Larnaca) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. This Order shall apply and shall be in operation in all towns and villages in the District of Larnaca.

3. All coffee-shops, clubs, restaurants, theatres, cinematograph theatres and cabarets shall be closed and remain closed except during the hours 6 a.m. and 12 midnight :
