ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 33 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 33 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Lighting of Vessels) Order, 1939.

2. No light shall be shown or exhibited between a quarter of an hour after sunset to a quarter of an hour before sunrise in or on any vessel moored berthed or at anchor within any port or harbour in the Colony unless the same shall have been adequately obscured to the satisfaction of the Competent Authority.

3. Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with the provisions of, this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
