THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) (FINANCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.

Dec. 9 1939 ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 7 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by regulation 7 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1939, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Restrictions on Dealings with Securities) Order, 1939.

2. No person being an owner of securities of any of the classes to which this Order applies shall on or after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, unless permission has previously been granted by the Exchange Officer, sell, transfer or do anything which involves the creation of a charge on any securities of the said classes.

The owners of any securities of the said classes shall before the ~~expiration of one month~~ from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* make a return to the Exchange Officer through a bank on the form provided for the purpose giving the following particulars with respect to those securities, that is to say,—

- (a) The full name and address of the owner by whom or on whose behalf the return is made,
- (b) A description of the security in full,
- (c) The nominal amount of the security,
- (d) The place where the security is deposited,
- (e) The full name and address of the person for whose account the security is held (if other than the owner making the return).

4. The classes of securities to which this Order applies are the following, that is to say,—

Securities in respect of which the principal, interest or dividends are payable in the currency of any of the following countries:—

Argentina	Norway
Belgium	Sweden
Canada	Switzerland
France	United States
Holland and the Dutch East Indies	

or in respect of which the holder has an option to require the payment of principal, interest or dividends in the currency of any of those countries.

5. Any person who acts in contravention of or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939. (M.P. 172/38.)
