THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1881

MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Orders, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order") and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Orders, 1939 to (No. 2) 1939.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following goods :—

"Sacks (Gunny bags), empty, and sacking material.

Sacks (Gunny bags), containing goods which in the opinion of the Comptroller are not normally exported in sacks."
