THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 42.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 42 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Motor Spirit) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Motor Spirit) Order, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Motor Spirit) Orders, 1939 to (No. 2) 1939.

2. Clause 6 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "to the Commissioner of the District" and by the substitution therefor of the words "to me at Nicosia".

3. Clause 8 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "to the Commissioner of the District" and by the substitution therefor of the words "to me at Nicosia".

4.—(1) Clause 11 of the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following clause is substituted therefor:—

"11. Any person wishing to sell or otherwise dispose of motor spirit by retail shall complete and deliver to me in duplicate at Nicosia an application for registration as a retailer together with a declaration in the form set forth in Schedule D hereto, and I may thereupon register such person as a registered retailer and give him a certificate accordingly."

(2) Any person who, under the provisions of clause 11 of the Principal Order, repealed by sub-clause (1) of this clause, has already been registered as a retailer by the Commissioner of the District and has obtained from him a certificate in respect thereof shall be deemed to be a registered retailer for the purposes of the said clause 11 as substituted by sub-clause (1) of this clause.

5. Clause 13 of the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following clause is substituted therefor:—

"13. No registered retailer shall sell or otherwise dispose of any motor spirit except to another registered retailer or to a registered

consumer and unless and until he shall have obtained at the same time from such registered retailer or registered consumer a purchase coupon or purchase coupons issued under the authority of a Commissioner and for a quantity equivalent to that disposed of."

6. Clause 14 of the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following clause is substituted therefor:—

"14. Each registered retailer shall within four days after the last day of each month complete and deliver to me in duplicate at Nicosia a return in the form set forth in Schedule E hereto in respect of any motor spirit purchased by him directly from a registered importer. He shall at the same time surrender to me purchase coupons corresponding to the quantities of such motor spirit disposed of by him during the aforesaid period of one month."

7. Clause 15 of the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following clause is substituted therefor:—

"15. No person except a registered consumer or a registered retailer shall purchase motor spirit by retail."

8. Clause 17 of the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following clause is substituted therefor:—

"17. No registered consumer shall purchase motor spirit except from a registered retailer and each registered consumer shall surrender to the registered retailer at the time of purchase a purchase coupon or purchase coupons for a quantity equivalent to the quantity of motor spirit purchased:

Provided that any registered consumer who is authorized to purchase a quantity of twelve gallons or more at any one time may obtain such quantity direct from a registered importer on surrendering to the latter purchase coupons of equivalent amount."

9. The following clauses shall be inserted in the Principal Order immediately after clause 18A thereof:—

"18B. Each registered consumer shall, on or before the 15th day of October, 1939, complete and deliver to me in duplicate at Nicosia a return in the Form No. 1 or No. 2, as the case may be, set forth in Schedule G hereto.

18C. Not more than one registered consumer shall obtain or attempt to obtain purchase coupons for motor spirit in respect of any one and the same motor vehicle or stationary engine.

18D. If any registered importer who holds any stock of motor spirit refuses, upon being offered the purchase price, to sell to any registered retailer or registered consumer any quantity of motor spirit which such retailer or consumer is authorized to buy, and such refusal is in my opinion unreasonable, such importer shall, at my request, deliver such quantity of motor spirit to such person as I may direct, to be disposed of in such manner and at such price as I may direct in that behalf."

10. Schedule C to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "To the Commissioner, District." and by the substitution therefor of the words "To the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Competent Authority, Nicosia."

11. Schedule D to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "To the Commissioner, District." and by the substitution therefor of the words "To the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Competent Authority, Nicosia."

12. Schedule E to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Schedule is substituted therefor:—

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Bread) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*—
2. No person shall—
 - (a) sell or purchase, or
 - (b) offer for sale or attempt to sell or purchase, or
 - (c) either directly or indirectly make any arrangement for the sale of, any bread in any village in the Colony except in loaves weighing—
 - (i) One-half oke (200 drams), or
 - (ii) One oke (400 drams).

3. Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of clause 2 of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
