THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)  
REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Sugar) Order, 1939.

2. Within five days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is a merchant, importer, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of sugar exceeding in the aggregate 78 okes in weight shall complete and deliver to the Commissioner of the District in which such person resides a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of sugar in his possession or under his control.

3. Subject to the proviso hereto, from and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person shall sell, or expose for sale, or otherwise dispose of, or remove from his premises, any sugar in his possession or under his control except under a permit in writing in that behalf previously obtained from the Commissioner of the District in which such person resides :

Provided that any person who—

(a) in carrying on his ordinary business sells, or exposes for sale, sugar may, subject to the provisions of the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Sugar) Order, 1939, sell or expose for sale any sugar in his possession, or

(b) in carrying on his ordinary business utilizes sugar for the purposes of such business may utilize sugar in his possession for the purposes of such business, or

(c) utilizes sugar for his ordinary domestic requirements may utilize sugar in his possession for such requirements,

without previously obtaining a permit in writing from the Commissioner of the District in that behalf.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize by writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes a false return under clause 2 of this Order,

shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
