**THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.**

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Alaminos, in the District of Larnaca, on the 12th day of March, 1939, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Alaminos:

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described:

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Alaminos has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Larnaca a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed:

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor:

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Alaminos.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Alaminos, in the District of Larnaca.

**SCHEDULE.**

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say:—

The boundary commences at the most western point of plot No. 85 of the Government Survey Plan No. L/49, on the road from the village of Kophinou to the village of Alaminos and on the boundary of the village of Alaminos, and proceeds northwards, north-westwards and south-westwards along this village boundary to the most eastern

point of plot No. 1 of the Government Survey Plan No. L/50, locality "Spitoudhia," on a track ; thence south-westwards along this track to the most southern point of plot No. 180 of the Government Survey Plan No. L/49 ; thence north-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 180, 118, 120/1, 102, 101, 68/1 and 99 to the most southern point of plot No. 68/1 of the said plan, locality "Mantidhes," on the road from the village of Alaminos to the village of Kophinou ; thence north-westwards along the said road to the point of commencement ; all which area includes 1,347 donums or thereabouts, as shown edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. 424/39.

**No. 291. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.**

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 216 published in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 2621 of the 3rd December, 1937, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a burial-ground for the burial of the dead by the Orthodox-Christian Community of the village of Galata, in the District of Nicosia :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that, from and after the 22nd day of October, 1939, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burial-ground above referred to has been provided.

**No. 292. The Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937.**

SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION UNDER SECTION 13A (1).

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 13A (1) of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, I hereby authorize the Mukhtars the names whereof are mentioned in the Schedule hereto to issue, on the application in writing of a Police Officer of any rank not lower than that of Corporal or of any Police Officer in charge of a Police Station, warrants for the purposes of the said section of the said Laws, in addition to the Mukhtars already authorized to issue such warrants.
