**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.**

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 1.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make and hereby makes the following regulations.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Amendment (No. 1) Regulations, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1939 to (No. 1) 1939.

2. These regulations shall come into operation on and from the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.

3. The following regulation shall be inserted in the Principal Regulations immediately after regulation 9 thereof:—

9A. Without prejudice to any special provision contained in these regulations, the Governor, or a person authorized by or on behalf of the Governor, may, for the purpose of securing compliance with these regulations, give to any person directions requiring him, within such time, in such a manner and to such person as may be specified in the directions, to furnish such information as may be so specified and to produce for inspection any relevant books, accounts or other documents."

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Sugar) Amendment Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Sugar) Order, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Sugar) Orders, 1939.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)  
REGULATIONS, 1939.**

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Amendment (No. 3) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Orders, 1939 to (No. 2) 1939, (hereinafter called “ the Principal Order ”), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Orders, 1939 to (No. 3) 1939.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—

4. Any other town or village not specifically enumerated above.	40 <i>piastres</i>	45 <i>piastres</i>	do.”
