THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Petrol) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Petrol) Orders, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Petrol) Orders, 1939 to (No. 2) 1939.

2. Clause 2 of the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following clause substituted therefor :—

"2. No person shall—

(a) sell or purchase, or

(b) offer for sale or attempt to sell or purchase, or

(c) either directly or indirectly make any arrangement for the sale or purchase of,

any petrol in any town or village in the Colony at a price in excess of the prices shown in the first, second and third columns of the Schedule hereto."

3. The following Schedule shall be inserted in the Principal Order at the end thereof :—

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Coffee) Order, 1939.

2. Within five days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is a merchant, importer, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of coffee exceeding in the aggregate 46 oke in weight shall complete and deliver to the Commissioner of the District in which such person resides a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of coffee in his possession or under his control.

3. Subject to the proviso hereto, from and after the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no person shall sell, or expose for

sale, or otherwise dispose of, or remove from his premises, any coffee in his possession or under his control except under a permit in writing in that behalf previously obtained from the Commissioner of the District in which such person resides :

Provided that any person who—

- (a) in carrying on his ordinary business sells, or exposes for sale, coffee may, subject to the provisions of the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Coffee) Order, 1939, sell or expose for sale any coffee in his possession, or
- (b) in carrying on his ordinary business utilizes coffee for the purposes of such business may utilize coffee in his possession for the purposes of such business, or
- (c) utilizes coffee for his ordinary domestic requirements may utilize coffee in his possession for such requirements,

without previously obtaining a permit in writing from the Commissioner of the District in that behalf.

4. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize by writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

5. Any person who—

- (a) acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or
 - (b) makes a false return under clause 2 of this Order,
- shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
