REGULATIONS, 1939.****ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Certain Petroleum Products) Amendment Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Certain Petroleum Products) Order, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Certain Petroleum Products) Orders, 1939.

2. Clause 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion of the words "the 20th day of August, 1939," and by the substitution therefor of the words "the 19th day of August, 1939,"; and

(b) by the insertion of the following proviso at the end thereof :—
"Provided that Shell Mineral Turpentine may be sold at a price not in excess of the official prices ruling therefor on the 19th day of August, 1939, plus two piastres per kilo."

No. 342.**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.****ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 9.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 9 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Places of Public Resort and Entertainments) (Famagusta-Varosha) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. This Order shall apply and be in operation in the Municipal area of Famagusta-Varosha.

3. All coffee-shops, clubs, restaurants, theatres, cinematograph theatres, confectioner's shops, cabarets and any other place or premises of public resort whatsoever shall be closed and remain closed except between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 midnight from the 1st June to the 30th September and between the hours of 6 a.m. and 11 p.m. from the 1st October to the 31st May in every year during the continuance of this Order :
