## THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Ground Pulse) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. For the purposes of this Order "pulse" means peas, beans, lentils and vetches.

3. No person shall—

(a) sell or purchase, or

(b) offer for sale or attempt to sell or purchase, or

(c) either directly or indirectly make any arrangement for the sale

or purchase of, any ground pulse specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto in any of the towns or villages in the Colony at a price in excess of the price shown in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the name of each such pulse.

4. No person shall sell by retail to any purchaser of ground pulse

more than one week's supply during any one week.

5. Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of clause 3 or 4 of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
