 THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
 REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Milling Charges) Order, 1939, and shall come into operation on and from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. No person shall—

(a) charge, or

(b) attempt to charge, or

(c) either directly or indirectly make any arrangements for charging, in any town or village of the Colony, for the conversion of any wheat into flour by milling, in excess of the charges specified in column 2 or 3, as the case may be, of Schedule A hereto, against the description of such flour in column 1 of the said Schedule.

3. No person shall—

(a) charge, or

(b) attempt to charge, or

(c) either directly or indirectly make any arrangements for charging, in any town or village of the Colony, for the conversion of any barley into flour by milling, in excess of the charges specified in column 1 or 2, as the case may be, of Schedule B hereto.

4. Any person who acts in contravention of any of the provisions of clause 2 or 3 of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.
